Rops Auctioneers to host the latest *Hergé* sale,

Rops Auction House (Namur, Belgium) is set to host the latest sale dedicated to the work of Hergé. The sale will take place in Rops' auction rooms – 320 Chaussée de Waterloo, 5002 Saint-Servais, Belgium – at 1pm on Sunday 22 May.

In May 2009 Rops organised – with the assistance of Studios Hergé and Moulinsart S.A. – its first *Hergé* sale, entirely dedicated to the work of the creator of Tintin. The sale was an extraordinary success and was widely covered by the Belgian and international press. A wide range of top quality items was showcased: original drawings, rare books (some signed) and diverse memorabilia including figurines, postcards, posters and other collectables.

Clients were overjoyed to see sales figures breaking records. Examples include the original plate for page 3 of *The Castafiore Emerald* reaching €312,500, and plate 38 of *The Calculus Affair* selling for €275,000.

In total 94% of lots were sold at consistently high prices. The total revenue of €1,172,000 was nearly double the pre-sale estimate of €654,000, demonstrating the passion and emotion that Hergé and his work continues to generate among the general public. Tintin continues to inspire generations of readers, and original work and derived products from the series are becoming increasingly sought-after.

To mark the second anniversary of the Hergé Museum a selection of lots will be exhibited on Saturday 21 May, from 1pm to 5pm, on the first floor of the Fondation Wallonne: 20 Green Lane (Cortil Le Coq Hardy) in Louvain-la-Neuve, close to the museum.

Rops invites owners of books and all items relating to Hergé and to his work, to profit from this unique opportunity to discover the value of their treasures.

With the first Tintin movie scheduled for release in October, 2011 is set to be a defining year for the series of Hergé sales!
